

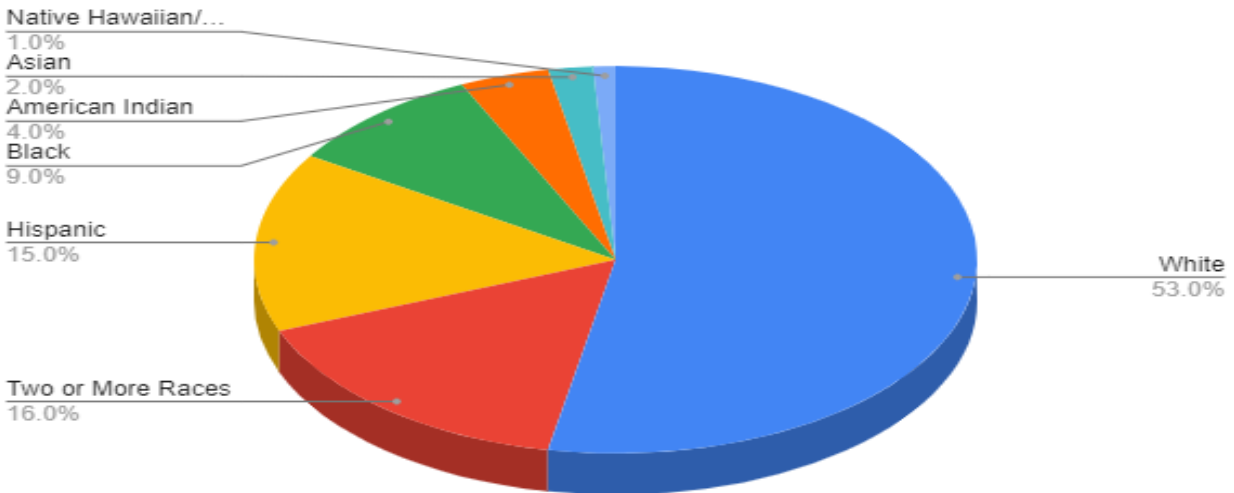

Norman High School began in 1890 with the construction of the township's first high school. It is a four-year public high school in Norman, Oklahoma with 2183 students enrolled in 2022-23. It is accredited by North Central Association, the Oklahoma State Department of Education and the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association. The school year consists of two 18-week semesters, with six class periods per day lasting fifty-five minutes.

The Class of 2023 is composed of 415 students: 214 male, 201 female. Forty-eight percent of students participate in the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program.

AEGIS Math Course Description: Select students are chosen each year to complete a two-year mathematics-intensive program. Students are chosen based on Cogat scores, PSAT/SAT scores, state testing, weighted and unweighted grades, and teacher recommendation. Students are required to take Trigonometry/Math Analysis in the regular curriculum. In addition, the students attend an AEGIS class where the following topics are covered: systems, set theory, logic, polynomials, logarithms, matrices, sequence, series and probability along with Calculus. The first year for these students includes Advanced Placement Calculus AB or Calculus I and selected math research topics, while the second year includes Advanced Placement Calculus BC or Calculus II, linear algebra and some Calculus III topics. More theory and proofs are discussed than in the AP Calculus course at NHS.

AEGIS English Course Description: The curriculum stresses written, college-level responses to classic literature, bibliographic and other literary research projects, personal essays, and creative writing in the genres of drama, poetry, and short fiction. A bill of one-act plays is produced each spring, drawing its material from plays written by AEGIS Juniors. Seniors in the program select a modern author to study the entire year, turning in a lengthy bibliographic project at the close of the first semester and a lengthy paper of critical assessment over one work of that author at the close of the Senior year. In one case, this project led to publication in an adult literary periodical. Students write papers of serious critical assessment, and in different areas different students are assigned research papers of serious length. The work accomplished allows students to develop a "college-level" attitude toward learning in general, and towards all types of composition and literary study in particular. Yearly, students are winners in national-level writing contests, including those sponsored by the National Council of Teachers of English and the Alliance for Young Artists and Writers.

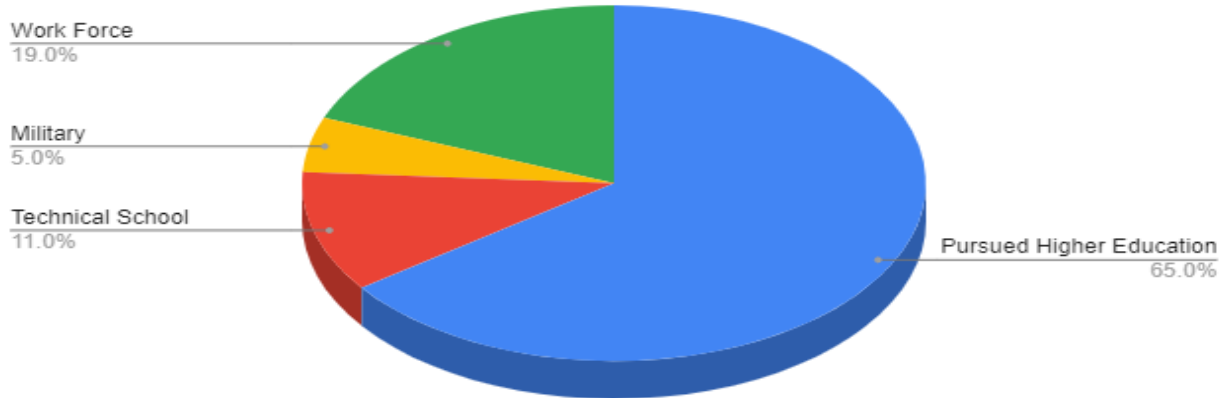
College Enrollment Statistics: Class of 2022

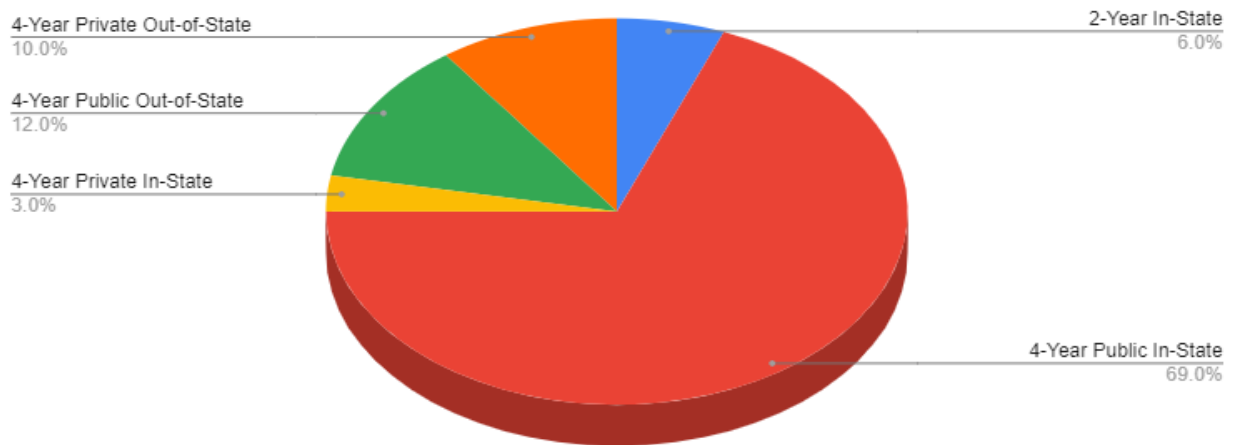
