



Foreign Exchange Students Information Sheet

- ❑ Student must have a J1 Visa
- ❑ Student must be 15 years of age or older
- ❑ Student must be registered with a program certified by Homeland Security
- ❑ NPS will only take five (5) students per high school
- ❑ The application and all it's information must be submitted to the Director of Secondary Education, who will in turn share with the site principal for approval
- ❑ If approved, the Director or Principal will sign the Enrollment Acceptance form, and return to the programs contact
- ❑ The Director's Administrative Assistant will send an email with the links to the following for the host family, along with who to contact at the school site:
 - a. NPS Online Registration
 - b. Home Language Survey
 - c. Health History form
 - d. High School Course Catalog

Timelines for submitting applications:

- NPS would like to receive these applications between the third Tuesday in February and the end of the school year.
- For the 2016-17 school year we would want applications between 2/16/16 and 5/27/16. We will accept applications after this if we have not filled all our allotted openings.
